REPORTS:

Tony Goldson updated on the plans for devolution

The Community Speedwatch scheme has been postponed pending investigation into a possible low cost Automatic Number Plate Recognition system.

Clerk has requested a quote to cut the verge, opposite The Plough to Mill Road, but still awaiting a response. SCC has advised that further cutting of their hedges due soon.

Additional lower light is now installed and operating in car park.

A site meeting with Suffolk Highways took place on 24th June to discuss hard entrance to car park. Waiting on them providing a contractor and quote.

Solicitors are dealing with the land near Rumburgh and preparing a statement to send to Land Registry. Clerk to take accounts book to Solicitor. A valuation has been obtained. The land has been registered for possible development under the Waveney Local Plan.

Clerk has registered for the possible installation of a mobile phone mast on behalf of the Parochial Church Council.

There was no update on the proposed storage facility from the Community Council.
