For the present time Derek Nunn is acting as temporary captain and Ernie is assisting.

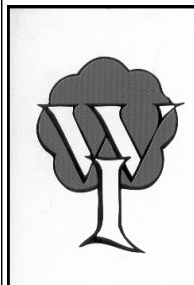
The club is out of the chairman's plate competition and we are now halfway through the winter league fixtures.
