Brian took us to the Royal Hospital at Chelsea, where the residents (male and female) can still be seen in scarlet coats, rows of medals and tricorne hats. We went to Bletchley Park to marvel at the incredible work that was done there to crack the enemy codes in the war – successfully. We visited Chatham Dockyard, where Brian could be found bravely exploring an early submarine, ignoring claustrophobia. And to Sandhurst Military Academy, where Brian himself had trained and where we were treated as honoured guests and not just tourists. Finally, he organised an outing to a final rehearsal for Trooping the Colour, successfully resisting the temptation to scoop up some of the manure from the horses to spread over his garden.

As anyone who has done it will tell you, these events don't just happen, but were all meticulously organised by Brian. So thank you for the memories but, if ever I go again to Chatham Dockyard, you won't find me in that submarine!

## COVID-19 - 29th May.

The latest instruction is that we can meet outside in our gardens or a public park. No more than 6 people together from two different households, keeping at least 6 feet apart.

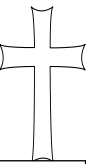
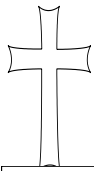

## PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

As there was no Parish Council meeting in May 2020 due to the Covid 19 situation, please see below a report on current matters, which are not formal notes to be approved and are for Parishioners information only.

### PARISH COUNCIL UPDATE

#### Coronavirus – Covid-19 Situation:

A second update card is due to be delivered to all homes in Wissett in the near future.

#### REPORTS:

Village Sign. Carving is expected to be complete in mid-June. Once complete, painting will start and is expected to take around 4 weeks. We hope the sign will be back with us circa mid-July. There is still a question whether the existing post can be used or if a new one should be arranged.

Potholes in layby outside Brickhill Cottages. Clerk has chased this again with SCC. They say they have issued the order but cannot contact the contractor, possibly down to situation. Will continue to monitor.

The road that floods outside Valley Farm Vineyards has had the drains rodded, but there is a blockage and it now requires a full survey. Tony Goldson has arranged for this to be done.

Footpath 6 (from opposite Bonds Farm entrance to around Ash Tree Farm) is now on the SCC list for consideration for clearance after bird nesting season later in the year. This will be dependent on their budget and other priority works at that time.

Footpath 4 has had reported unauthorised works/landfill adjacent to the public footpath near Hill Farm on Rumburgh Road. SCC environment team have referred this onto the Environment Agency for further investigation. Peter Aldous and Tony Goldson are both aware and involved.

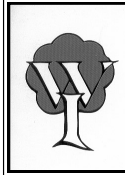
